SWIMMING WAIKATO'S TIERED SWIMMING MEETS

Level 1 Meets – All swimmers will have achieved National Age Group Qualifying Times.

Level 2 Meets – Level 2 meets are for swimmers who have qualified for Div II but have not qualified for National Age Groups.

Level 3 Meets – Level 3 meets are for swimmers who have not qualified for Div II or any higher national meet.

A swimmer must have swum **one qualifying time** to allow them to enter and compete at that Level of Meet.

You will note that we are using qualifying times for National Events as the qualifying standards for these levels. Although these National qualifying times relate to swimmers aged 12 and over, the same qualifying times will apply to our junior swimmers as they compete at our Waikato meets, ie. an 11 year old swimmer is not eligible to compete at Div II, but if they have swum a Div II qualifying time, they will compete at Swimming Waikato's Level 2 meets.



CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Only registered **competitive** swimmers are eligible to enter.
- Age as at the first day of the meet.
- Swimmers may only enter **ONE** of the following events: 400m Freestyle or 400m Individual Medley
- Swimmers may only enter **ONE** of the following events: 200m Breaststroke, 200m Backstroke, 200m Butterfly
- **Entry process:** Entries must be submitted via Club Recorders in the TM format, together with entry and fee reports to: aceentries@gmail.com
- Entry times to be converted to Long Course (50m) times.
- **Entry Fees:** Individual entry \$7.50. GST inclusive.
- **Entries Close:** Midnight, Sunday 8th November 2015.
- **Payment of Fees:**

- Entry fees are to be received by 21 November 2015 and accompanied by a Meet Entry Fee Report or summary.
- There will be no refunds on entry fees except as per the scratching rules.

- Swimmers must comply with Swimming Waikato's 'Tiered Swimming Meets' rules listed on this flyer.
- Submission of entries constitutes acceptance of these Meet Rules and Conditions. NO TIME is not accepted.
- Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under IPC Swimming Rules. Para swimmers must present their classification card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of the meet.
- The Meet Director reserves the right to restrict entries to ensure the timeline as per Swimming Waikato's Competitive Pathway is adhered to.
- Late entries will be at the Meet Director's discretion based on lane space availability, late entry fee \$10.00 per event, swimmers will not be eligible for prizes or points; these will be swum as exhibition swims only.
- Please check names, entries and events are correct on receipt of information. Corrections will only be made to entries where errors have occurred. Psych sheets will be posted on Swimming Waikato website.
- Participants who have entered this meet agree to allow photograph, video, multimedia or film likeness taken by accredited photographers approved by Swimming Waikato to be used for any legitimate purpose by Swimming Waikato, a Club affiliated to Swimming Waikato, or local media.



MEET RULES

General -

- The meet will be conducted under Swimming New Zealand's 'SNZ Regulations and Bylaws, FINA Rules' except where local meet rules and conditions apply.
- All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.
- Events will be swum as **Mixed Gender/ Graded Scratch**.
- Reseeding may be done at the discretion of the Meet Director.
- Electronic Timing will be used at this meet and there will be up to three timekeepers per lane. Over the top starts will apply for individual events.
- Protests shall be lodged as per SNZ Regulation 4 accompanied with the \$100 fee.
- Entry into the pool for backstroke events shall be feet first. No swim back permitted.
- Please exit the pool at the side. Do not swim over the lane ropes.

Scratchings/Withdrawals -

- Scratchings for the meet must be submitted at least 30 minutes before the start of the session to the Meet Recorder.
- Swimmers will be deemed to have withdrawn if they do not report to marshalling prior to their race.

Officials -

Officials are required to report to the referee at the start of warm-up please. Referees, IOTs & the Chief Timekeeper need to report in plenty of time.

As per Swimming New Zealand regulations, there is a minimum number and standard of officials required for a meet to be classed as approved and for those times to be used for national qualification. More information can be found at <http://www.swimming.org.nz/page.php?id=1002>.
