CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- This event is for **COMPETITIVE** and **CLUB** swimmers only who are registered in the SNZ database and are financial as at the date of the meet and are:
 - aged 13+ as at the first day of the meet: OR
 - aged 12/U as at the first day of the meet and have swum the following qualifying time in the 200m Individual Medley event. Junior swimmers who have swum this qualifying time are then eligible to compete in any event at this meet -
BOYS— 3:06.90 (sc) GIRLS— 3:10.30 (sc)
- Swimmers have the opportunity to gain qualifying times for Regional, Zonal and National Meets.
- **ENTRIES CLOSE** : on the SNZ database on Sunday 14 May 2017 at 11.59pm.

- All events are **TIMED FINALS**
- All events will be swum as mixed gender
- Entry times long course. Times may be converted from SC times.
- **“NO TIME”** will not be accepted.
- Meet Director reserves the right to restrict event numbers if entries exceed the nominated time-frame. The nominated timeframe for XLR8 Series meets is 4 hours per session (including warm up).
- **Entry process:** Entries to be submitted via the SNZ National database. Individuals will be able to access and complete their entries online via the database.
- **Entry Fees:** Individual entry: \$8.00. GST Inclusive.
Relay entries: \$8.00 per team. GST Inclusive. Clubs will be invoiced for the relay entry fee once entries close.

- Payments by cheque must be from the Club Account and be accompanied by a Meet Entry Fee Report.
- There will be no refunds on entry fees except as per the scratching rules.
- Submission of Entries constitutes acceptance of these Meet Rules & Conditions
- Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under IPC Swimming Rules. Para swimmers must present their classification card to the Meet Director prior to the commencement of the meet.
- Late entries will be at the Meet Director’s discretion based on lane space availability, late entry fee \$10.00 per event.
- Psych sheets will be circulated once entries have been closed. Each Club is responsible for checking names, entries and events are correct on receipt of information and advising Swimming Waikato of any errors by Friday 19 May 2017 Corrections will only be made to entries where errors have occurred. Final psych sheets will be posted on the website and sent out a minimum of five days before the start of the meet.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Participants who have entered this meet agree to allow photograph, video, multimedia or film likeness taken by accredited photographers approved by Swimming Waikato to be used for any legitimate purpose by Swimming Waikato, a Club affiliated to Swimming Waikato or local media.

General—

- The meet will be conducted under Swimming New Zealand's SNZ Regulations and Bylaws, FINA Rules' except where local meet rules and conditions apply.
- All participants must agree to comply with the Sports Anti-Doping Rules.
- Protests shall be lodged as per SNZ Regulation 4, accompanied by the \$100 fee.
- Reseeding may be done at the discretion of the Meet Director.
- Please clear any strapping with the Meet Director prior to the start of racing. It is the swimmer's responsibility to ensure this is done.
- Manual timekeeping will be used at this meet which requires three timekeepers per lane. Clubs are required to submit their list of timekeepers by Friday 19 May 2017.
- Over the top starts will apply for all events.
- Entry into the pool for the backstroke events shall be feet first. No swim back permitted.
- Please exit the pool at the side. Do not swim over the lane ropes.

Scratchings/Withdrawals -

- In all competitions, a competitor or team not wishing to take part in a preliminary final, semi-final and final in which qualification was earned shall withdraw within 30 minutes following the preliminaries or the semifinals of the event in which the qualification took place. Any competitor or team who withdraws from preliminary finals, semi-finals and finals more than 30 minutes after the preliminary or semi-final in which qualification was earned shall pay without excuse to Swim Waikato a fee as determined by Swim Waikato.
- For timed finals, withdrawals must be advised by the end of the session preceding the start of the timed final event.
- Scratchings for the first session must be submitted to the Control Room no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of racing.
- Swimmers will be deemed to have withdrawn if they do not report to the Clerk of Course (Marshall) at the appropriate time prior to their event.

Officials

- As per Swimming New Zealand regulations, there is a minimum number of accredited and financial officials required for meet to be classed as approved and for those times to be used for national qualification. Strapping/Tape

- As from the 1st of January 2017 swimmers with strapping at Waikato regional or club meets must provide suitable documentation from a relevant registered health practitioner or physiotherapist and be reviewed by the Meet Director prior to swimming.
