



Teacher of Competitive Swimming



A coach with this qualification will be able to deliver training sessions that develop swimming technique and attitudes of novice and junior swimmers – generally defined as swimmers 12 years and under - who are still acquiring the skills needed to compete successfully. The coach may work independent of any supervision as they are fully qualified to provide such delivery. Coaches at this level are encouraged to work with older swimmers to gain experience with this level as an 'assistant coach' under the supervision of a coach with appropriate qualifications.

Cost:

\$200.00 incl GST

Duration:

1 day + post course work

Teacher of Competitive Swimming is a one day course with additional post course work. The course includes presentations, discussions, and practical pool sessions.
