Conditions of Entry:

- Right to compete at this meet:
- All swimmers MUST BE SNZ registered and financial.
 Open to all ages SNZ Registered Competitive and SNZ Registered Club swimmers from ALL REGIONS.
- Technical Director reserves the right to **restrict event numbers** if entries exceed the nominated time frame.
- Age as at 28th September 2019.
- Entry Process: Entries to be submitted via Swimming NZ National database.
- Payment of Fees: Online via Swimming NZ database.
- Entries Close: Midnight Sunday 15th September 2019.
- 200m events: 3 & 4, swimmer may only enter 1x of these events.
- 200m events: 11 & 12, swimmer may only enter 1x of these events.
- Entry fee: \$45.00 per swimmer (maximum 5 individual events).
- **Refunds:** Will only be given when a Medical Certificate is supplied, or at the discretion of the Technical Director.
- **Relays:** \$4.00 per team Relay teams **MUST BE SUBMITTED** by club recorders, by 8.00pm Saturday 21st September No time required No relay entries accepted on the day.
- Entry times to be converted to **Short Course (25m) times**.
- All events swum as Mixed Graded Scratch.
- Swimmers with No Times will not be accepted "Club night times accepted".
- NOTE SWIMMERS with NT: If you enter any events with NT please advise your club recorder to supply an entry time to the Ace Recorder by Wednesday 8pm 18th September. Send to: aceentries@gmail.com
- NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED.

- ALL SWIMMERS and RECORDERS please check preliminary Psych Sheets "Posted on Swimming Waikato website" to ensure all data has been uploaded correctly – No amendments will be made after final Psych sheets have been posted.
- The meet programme, along with time guideline (guide only) will be uploaded to the Swimming Waikato website and forwarded to Club Recorders, prior to the start of the meet.
- Chocolate bars will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, 3rd placing in each heat.
- Chocolate sweets will be given to all other swimmers in each heat.
- Kick Board Relay: Team of 4x (Can be Male, Female or Mixed Teams) swimmers must complete 25m individually with 1x hand in contact with kick board at all times, finish length by touching the pool end with board and handing board on to next swimmer. The kick board cannot be used as a swimming aid (SW 10.7) e.g. paddle.
- 3 Legged Relay: Team of 4x (Can be Male, Female or Mixed Teams) swimmers will complete 25m in pairs with 1x leg of each swimmer joined by a rubber band, finish the length by both touching the pool end and handing rubber band on to the next 2x swimmers.
- The meet will be conducted under Swimming New Zealand's 'SNZ Regulations and Bylaws,
 FINA Rules' except where local meet rules and conditions apply.
- Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under IPC Swimming Rules. Para swimmers must present their classification card to the Technical Director prior to the commencement of the meet.
- All swimmers agree to comply with the anti-doping rules.
- Technical / Performance Race suits BANNED for all junior swimmers (swimmers aged 12 years and under) at all Swimming Waikato meets from 14th March 2019 as per policy on SW website.
- **Swimmers with Strapping** Must provide documentation from a relevant registered health practitioner or physiotherapist and be reviewed by the Technical Director prior to swimming. Any swimmers without such documentation will not be permitted to swim.
- Participants who have entered this meet agree to allow photograph, video, multimedia or film likeness taken by accredited photographers to be used for any legitimate purpose by Ace Swimming Club and Swimming Waikato.
- No Swim Teams are to be based on pool deck.
- The length of break between sessions will be at the discretion of the Technical Director on the day.
- Hamilton Aquatics will endeavor to supply the required number of officials to comply with SNZ Meet Approval regulations, please All Clubs are required to help us by supplying officials and timekeepers as per club allocation which will be sent to clubs after entries have been received. Officials' names and contact details would be appreciated. Your clubs support is always most appreciated to run a successful meet.
