The Hamilton Aquatics Cash Meet is the first Long Course in Waikato for 2021.

This meet's emphasis is to provide a competition that will play a crucial part in preparing swimmers and coaches leading up to the national summer competitions.

By bringing a more substantial age group and open level competition into the Waikato, we aim to provide our top-level athletes with more robust competition. With an emphasis on promoting faster swimming and giving swimmers an opportunity to focus on areas they wish to improve on.

The aim is to create a meet with a point of difference from the normal, to promote and reward high individual achievement.

Conditions of Entry

- Open to all Competitive and Club swimmers from ALL REGIONS.
- Open to all Para swimmers from ALL REGIONS.
- All swimmers MUST be SNZ registered "Competitive or Club.
- All entries must be submitted through the SNZ Database.
- The Meet director reserves the right to restrict event numbers if entries exceed the nominated time frame.
- Age as of 30th January 2021.
- Entry fee: \$10.00 per event.
- Entry times to be converted to Long Course (50m) times.
- All events swum Mixed Graded Scratch.
- Swimmers may enter up to a Maximum of 8x Individual Events Only.
- Close of entries: 8pm Sunday 17th January 2021.
- All entries must be submitted SNZ Database.
- No late entries accepted.
- Age Groups Male & female
 - o 12 & under
 - o **13 & 14**
 - o **15 & 16**
 - o **17 & O**
- Bonus cash prize for the top male & female FINA Points at meet, regardless of age.
- Cash prize Para Swimmers: Best % of World Record in any individual event regardless of age.
- Cash prizes are for the below grouping.
 - Cash prize Age Groups Combined total FINA Points at the meet.
 - 1st male \$150
 - 1st female \$150
 - o Cash prize Para Swimmers Best % of World Record in any individual event.
 - Ist male \$150
 - 1st female \$150
 - Cash prize Bonus Highest overall combined FINA Points at meet, regardless of age.
 - 1st male & female \$1000 each
 - 2nd male & female \$300 each
 - 3rd male & female \$200 each
- The scoring system is based on the highest overall combined FINA Points total for the swimmers selected events at the meet (Maximum allowed 8x events).
- FINA Points and the final tally will be generated by Hamilton Aquatics using the Meet Manager programme on the day of the meet.
- All SWIMMERS and RECORDERS please check preliminary Psych Sheets posted on Swimming Waikato & Hamilton Aquatics websites.
- No amendments will be made after final Psych sheets have been posted.
- The meet programme, along with a timeline (guide only) will be uploaded to the Hamilton Aquatics and Swimming Waikato websites and forwarded to club recorders and all competitors by email.
- Reseeding may be done at the discretion of the Technical Director.

Conditions of Racing

- Over the top starts will apply for all events.
- Please exit the pool from the side.
- Marshalling Procedure.
 - Self-marshalling will be employed during all events.
- The meet will be conducted under Swimming New Zealand's 'SNZ Regulations and Bylaws, FINA rules' except where local meet rules and conditions apply.
- Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under IPC Swimming Rules.
 - Para swimmers must present their classification card to the Technical Director prior to the commencement of the meet. The Referee will use their best efforts to judge the swim under the applicable IPC Rules.
- All swimmers agree to comply with the anti-doping rules.
- Swimmers with strapping must provide documentation from a registered health practitioner or physiotherapist to Technical Director prior to swimming. Swimmers without such documentation will not be permitted to swim.
- Participants who have entered this meet agree to allow photographs, video, multimedia, or film likeness taken by accredited photographers to be used for any legitimate purpose by Hamilton Aquatics Inc and Swimming Waikato.
- No swim teams are to be based on the pool deck.
- Hamilton Aquatics will endeavour to supply the required number of officials to comply with SNZ regulations, please help us by supplying officials and timekeepers as per club allocation which will be sent to clubs after entries have been received. Officials' names and contact details would be appreciated.
- Scratching/Withdrawals
 - Refunds will only be made if a medical certificate is provided to the Technical Director. All refunds are at the discretion of the Technical Director.
- Protests
 - Protests must be submitted within 30 minutes following the conclusion of the respective event. The protest fee of \$100.00 is payable upon submission of the correctly completed Protest Form.
- Spectator entry is \$2.00 pp as per Waterworld fee.
