Privacy Policy

Swimming Waikato is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. This notice describes our Privacy Policy. The words "we" and "our" where used in this Privacy policy mean Swimming Waikato. By visiting this website, you are accepting the practices described in this Privacy Policy.

1. What personal information do we collect?

1.1 - Becoming a Member: As part of becoming a member of Swimming New Zealand (SNZ) you are asked that you complete an online form which asks for information about you, such as your name, personal details (including your email address) and swimming history. This information is held on SNZ's membership database and Swimming Waikato has access to this database. We also collect personal information when swimmers apply for the regional squads and provide their details on our website.

1.2 - Information from other sources: we may also collect information about you from the swimming club to which you belong, other organisations which are affiliated to us, the NZOC, and Drug Free Sport NZ. Otherwise, we do not collect information about you from other sources unless it is in the public domain or you have authorised us to do so.

2. How we use your personal information

2.1 - We may use your personal information for several reasons, namely:

- (a) To personalise and improve your experience on this website or with Swimming Waikato.
- (b) To communicate with you in relation to any matter relevant to Swimming Waikato, SNZ, your club, and this website and swimming generally.
- (c) To monitor website usage.
- (d) To provide you with information from third parties (e.g., sponsors) which we think would be of interest to you.

2.2 - Where we communicate with you for marketing purposes, we will comply with the Unsolicited Electronic Messages Act 2007. This means that we will provide you with instructions for unsubscribing from such messages if you choose.

3. Who has access to your personal information?

3.1 - We will never sell your personal information.

3.2 - Employees and appointed officials: employees and appointed officials of Swimming Waikato have access to your personal information to carry out their roles within our organisation. Their access to your personal information is limited depending on the nature of their role.

3.3 - Clubs, SNZ, affiliated organisations, and other sporting bodies: we are sometimes required to share your personal information with the swimming club to which you belong or have applied for membership, SNZ, other organisations which are affiliated to us to which you belong or have applied for membership, Drug Free Sport NZ, Sport New Zealand, High Performance Sport New Zealand, the NZOC and FINA. You consent to your personal details being disclosed to these organisations. Where we disclose your personal information with these bodies, we shall use our discretion to only share such personal information as is necessary.

3.4 - Agents and subcontractors: we sometimes employ other companies and individuals to perform functions on our behalf. They have access to personal information needed to perform their functions but may not use it for other purposes.

3.5 - Sponsors: we do not share your personal information with our sponsors except with your consent.

3.6 - You: you have rights of access to and correction of your personal information in accordance with the Privacy Act 1993. If you wish to update your information, please email our Privacy Officer: angeline@swimmingwaikato.co.nz

3.7 - Releasing information to third parties: we release account and other personal information when we believe release is appropriate to comply with the law; or protect our rights, property, or safety, or that of our users, or others. This includes exchanging information with other companies and organisations for fraud protection and credit risk reduction. Obviously, however, this does not include selling, renting, sharing, or otherwise disclosing personally identifiable information from clients for commercial purposes in violation of the commitments in this Privacy Policy. Otherwise, you will receive notice if we intend to share your personal information with third parties and will have the right to choose not to share your information.

4. How we protect your information

4.1 - The internet is not a secure medium. However, we have put in place various security measures as set out in this policy:

(a) Firewalls: Our membership database and website are protected by a firewall.

(b) Password protection: Access to our membership database can only be made with a password.
