The 12 & U will gain XLR8 points and experience while swimming at an official meet.

Conditions of Entry:



This meet is open to **ALL CLUB AND COMPETITIVE SWIMMERS** who are registered in the SNZ database and are financial as at the date of the meet. The meet will be conducted under "SNZ Regulations and Bylaws and Fina Rules", except where local meet rules and conditions apply.

Age as at 29th of October 2022.

There is no qualifying times for this meet.

Entry times Long Course. Times may be converted from Short Course.

No times (NT) will not be accepted.

Recorders must send through club times by 8pm Monday, 24/10/22

All events are Timed Finals except events 5 and 6, 50m Freestyle, where the top 8 Male & Female Swimmers will compete in Skinz.

To qualify for the Skinz events you must enter at least 3 other events and finish in the top 8 Male & Female at the 50m Freestyle event.

Session one: Event 23 and 24, 400m Freestyle is open for 12 & Over.

Session two: Only 1 event can be entered from events 28 or 29 (200 back or 200 breast) not both. Session two starts 45 minutes after the Skinz concludes.

Technical director reserves the right to restrict event numbers if entries exceed the nominated timeframe. Reseeding may be done at the discretion of the technical director. Technical Director TBC.

Entry Process: Entries to be submitted via Fastlane, <u>Swimming New Zealand Fast Lane</u>

Submission of entries constitutes acceptance of these meet rules & conditions.

Entry Fees: Individual race entry: \$10.00 GST inclusive.
Entry Opens: 8.00am, Thursday, the 1st of September 2022.
Entry Closes: 11.59pm, Thursday the 20th of October 2022

Payment of Late Fees: Fairfield's Swimming Club account (contact: andrea.mcduff@bes.co.nz)

Late entries will be at the Technical Directors discretion based on lane space availability. Late entry will incur a fee of \$30.00 per swimmer which must be paid into FFD's account prior to the start of the meet. No late entries will be admitted from Monday the 24th of October 2022, 12.00 pm.

There will be no refunds on entry fees except as per the scratching rules.

Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under IPC Swimming Rules. Para swimmers must present their classification card to the meet director prior to the commencement of the meet.







Conditions of Entry:

Psych sheets will be circulated once entries have been closed. Competitors are responsible for checking names, entries and events are correct on receipt of information and advising Fairfield Swim Club Recorder of any errors by 8pm, Monday the 24th October 2022. Corrections will only be made to entries where errors have occurred.

Final psych sheets will be posted on the Swimming Waikato website on Tuesday, 25/10/2022.

This is a paperless meet. The meet programme, along with a timeline (guide only) will be available on the Swimming Waikato website on Thursday 27th October 2022, and emailed to the club recorders, coaches and competitors. No programmes will be for sale at the pool.

Access to the meet will be via the main entrance at Waterworld. Spectator fee entry \$2.00 applies. Team coaches, managers, officials, time-keepers and swimmers are exempt from this charge. Please supply the names on the link below to allow preparation of the entry list. Only those whose names appear on the list will be allowed free entry into the complex.

Participants who have entered this meet agree to allow photograph, video, multimedia or film likeness taken by accredited photographers approved by Swimming Waikato, a club affiliated to Swimming Waikato or local media.

General:

The meet will be conducted under Swimming New Zealand's (SNZ) Regulations and Bylaws, FINA Rules', except where local meet rules and conditions apply.

All participants must agree to comply with the sports anti-doping rules.

Protests must be submitted within 30 minutes following the conclusion of the respective event.

The protest fee is a \$100.00 payable upon submission of the correctly completed protest form.

Over the top starts will apply for all events.

Entry into the pool for the backstroke events shall be feet first. No swim back permitted.

Please exit the pool at the side. Do not swim over the lane ropes.

Disqualifications will be announced and a copy will be available at the announcer's desk.

Swimmers with strapping must provide documentation from a relevant registered health practitioner or physiotherapist and be reviewed by the technical director prior to swimming. Any swimmers without documentation will not be permitted to swim.







Conditions of Entry:

Timing: Either electronic timing (touch pads & button back up with 2 timekeepers per lane) or manual timing (3 timekeepers per lane) will be used at this meet.

The clubs will be given their timekeeper allocation.

All cubs are required to provide 1 Timekeeper / 4 swimmers.

Ratios for Coaches/Team Managers - 1-10 swimmers = 2 coaches/managers, 11-20 swimmers = 3 coaches/managers, 21-30 swimmers = 4 coaches/managers, 31+ swimmers = 5 coaches/managers.

Skinz:

The Skinz races will be the fastest 8 female and male swimmers from events 5 and 6. They will swim 50m Freestyle every 2 min 30sec with the slowest swimmer in each round being eliminated. The Skins will start at the conclusion of Session 1.

Entry to the skinz races can only be achieved by finishing in the Top 8, 13 & Over category, in events 5 and 6 and by swimming at least 3 other events.

Marshalling:

Self Marshalling for the session one. Marshalling will be available for the session two only (12U).

Scratchings / Withdrawals:

Refunds will only be made if a medical certificate is provided to the meet recorder. All refunds are at the discretion of the technical director. No refunds for any withdrawals before or during the meet without a medical certificate.

Swimmers will be deemed to have withdrawn if they do not report to the control room at the appropriate time prior to their event.

Officials:

As per Swimming New Zealand regulations, there is a minimum number of voting technical officials required for a designated meet to be classed as approved. It is the responsibility of the clubs and members of the swimming community to ensure they contribute to the success of the meet assisting with the provision of officials. When the required number of officials are not forthcoming, the results from the meet will be unapproved.
