- Entry times are to be converted to Long Course (50m) times
- All events swum Mixed Graded Scratch. Swimmers with 'no times' will not be accepted

CONDITIONS

- Para swimmers are eligible to compete at this meet and shall compete under IPC Swimming
- Rules All swimmers agree to comply with the anti-doping rules
- Technical / performance suits are BANNED for all junior swimmers (age 12U) at all Swimming Waikato events as per the policy on the SW website
- Swimmers with strapping must provide documentation from a registered health practitioner or physiotherapist to the Technical Director prior to swimming
- Participants who have entered this meet agree to allow photographs, video, multimedia, or film likeness taken by accredited photographers to be used for any legitimate purpose by Matamata Swimming Club
- Over-the-top starts will apply for all events All swimmers must exit the pool from the side
- The length of the break between session will be at the discretion of the Technical Director on the day
- Matamata Swimming Club will endeavour to supply the required number of officials to comply with SNZ regulations.
 Please help us by supplying officials and timekeepers as per your club allocation, which will be sent to all clubs after entries have been received.
- Please note all clubs are required to help by supplying officials and timekeepers.
