XLR8 Program Focus

Swimming Waikato runs the XLR8 program to aid long term swimmer development and this is something all our junior swimmers should be aware of and trying to improve their point score. XLR8 promotes well rounded athletes who can swim a variety of events. Your XLR8 score is made up of scoring across 4 events, a distance free and IM (distance dependant upon age), a 200m non-free event and an optional event. The ethos of Hamilton Aquatics Race Night

Race night is a friendly, fun & inclusive environment for swimmers to get their first taste of competition. In addition, it provides the first opportunity for swimmers to gain times to enter future swim meets and allows our coaches' a chance to watch their technique and skills. All ages and levels are encouraged to enter a range of strokes and distances.

The night will run like a 'normal swim meet' as possible, for our less experienced athletes to understand meet procedures, officials, rules, whistle meanings, marshalling and swim protocol. Furthermore, it allows new parents to understand the procedures, Meet Conditions of Entry (as below), meet other parents and get fully immersed in the swimming culture!

Meet Conditions of Entry:

- Right to compete at this meet: All swimmers must be Hamilton Aquatics Registered and Financial. Invited other clubs &/or groups only.
- Entry Process: SNZ Competitive | Club | LTS Entries to be submitted online through Fastlane via the Swimming New Zealand National database. Non-SNZ swimmers or Swimmer's part of Learn to Swim program Email their entries directly to recorder@hamiltonaquatics.nz.
- Refunds: No Refunds will not be given unless the Recorder is notified by email prior to the start of Meet. All refunds will be at the discretion of the technical director.
- Entries Close 11.59pm Tuesday 10th October 2023
- Entry fee: \$3.00 per event.
- All events are swum as Mixed Graded Scratch.
- Swimmers with No Times (NT) will be seeded with their own age group.
- All swimmers please check preliminary Psych sheets. Psych sheets will be sent to all club members to
 ensure all data has been uploaded correctly. No amendments will be made after final Psych sheets
 have been posted.
- The meet will be conducted with several qualified and training officials, run as close as possible to a regular swim meet, for learning for swimmer's officials and parents of SNZ meet competition rules.
- Parent volunteer help is required to be able to run the meet, please come along and get involved, meet other parents, and try out in different official roles. This is a learning experience for all.
- Participants who have entered this meet agree to allow photographs, video, multimedia, or film likeness taken by accredited photographers to be used for any legitimate purpose by Hamilton Aquatics Inc. If you have requested your child, not be photographed, please let us know and we will ensure it does not happen.
